Conformation: Enter versatility horse in division you are competing for conformation
 AND enter versatility horse in appropriate age/sex conformation class (required)

The versatility class choices must be indicated on the entry form with an X in the V column prior to 3 pm Friday start of the show.

FQHR Versatility Competition Rules for 3-5 Open and 3-5 Amateur Divisions

Only the highest point horse/rider combination in each 3-5 versatility division (using points from their chosen versatility classes) will be awarded at the 2026 FQHR World Round Up.

Conformation: Enter versatility horse in division you are competing for conformation (e.g. Versatility 3-5 Open)
AND enter versatility horse in appropriate age/sex conformation class (e.g. 3-5 Geldings)

You may enter other 3-5 year old classes, but you need to indicate which classes you want points to be taken from for the versatility competition. If you enter your horse into classes in different than 3-5 age division, your horse will be disqualified from the 3-5 versatility competition.

The versatility class choices must be indicated on the entry form with an X in the V column prior to 3 pm Friday, start of the show.

FQHR YEARLING AND 2 YEAR OLD

Must show in the correct ages classes in the in hand trail and Conformation and the horse with the most points using the high point system will be the “In The Lead” Champion.

SHOW, RANCH, COW, SPEED CHAMPION

Must enter 3 classes in EACH division and the person with the highest points total in that division will be the Champion.
